Zoe: Equipping orphaned children and youth-led families with solutions to overcome extreme poverty—for good.

Henderson Settlement: Funding to assist a poverty stricken area of the Appalachia.

LOCAL

Blessing Box: Support for our Skyland box. This box provide necessities for our housed and unhoused neighbors.

All Souls Counseling: Providing quality mental health counseling, outreach, and education with a focus on those who are underinsured and uninsured in Western North Carolina.

ABBC Medical Clinic: Funding a free clinic so the uninsured have access to medical care, dental care and medicine.

Haywood Street Congregation: Relationship, above all else - a ministry serving the unhoused in our community.

MANNA: A monthly grocery market held at Skyland for those who are in need of food support.

ABCCM Feeding the Homeless: A monthly meal provided and served to either Transformation Village or the Veteran's Restoration Quarters.

Habitat for Humanity: Funding and labor support for building houses in our community.

Bridges Reading Enrichment: Funding and volunteers helping children from Estes Elementary to become reading proficient.

Creation Care Alliance: A team who inspires and mobilizes individuals and faith communities to care for God's creation.

MANNA Market Diapers: Skyland provides diapers for the shoppers of our monthly Manna Market.

UNCA Wesley Student Ministry: Providing financial assistance for programs provided to college students.

Around the Son Preschool Teacher Appreciation: Monthly outreach to the teachers of our Skyland sponsored preschool.

Homeward Bound - Welcome Home: Provides resources and support for our neighbors moving from being unhoused into housing.

Congregations for Children / Estes: Skyland's relationship with Estes Elementary to assist guidance counselors with students needs.

ARC of Buncombe: Serving children and Adults with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities for Over 60 Years.

Haywood Street Respite: Haywood Street Respite is a safe place for unhoused adults to rest, get three meals a day, and be helped in other ways to "get back on their feet" following discharge from the hospital.

ABCCM Crisis South: This ministry serves the low-income citizens of Buncombe County who are facing financial emergencies and are struggling to meet life's basic needs.

Swannanoa Correctional Center For Women: Assisting with the salary for a pastor to provide spiritual guidance and worship for females inmates.

Blood Drive: An opportunity to donate blood at Skyland four times a year.
